

# Hamm HD14 VV Tandem Drum Roller

NZG 1:50th Scale

**T**he Hamm HD14 VV is an articulating tandem drum roller with two vibratory drums, tipping the scales at 4.3 ton and powered by a Kubota 4-cylinder engine. The new 1:50th scale model from NZG is an update to the earlier design,

featuring new tooling for the engine cover, side drum frames and grab rails fitted to the operator's station. It has working articulated steering and a fully populated driver area showing the steering wheel and control levers while the ROP's frame is topped with an amber beacon.

The markings reflect the latest corporate design and are crisply applied. Fine detailing includes the painted light lenses front and back while the engine cover has black highlighted engine grills with silver dots representing the bolt heads on the roller frames.
